

Registration for the POS Summer Exhibition is now open!



Where: Birnam Arts
When: **1st to 16th July, open daily 10am to 5pm**
Who: Members of POS
What: A single piece of art (or up to 12 small items on a display case shelf)
Registration closes: **31st May 2023**

PLEASE READ THE WHOLE DOCUMENT BEFORE SUBMITTING YOUR REGISTRATION FOR THE POS SUMMER EXHIBITION.

1. Members-only exhibition

You have to be a member of Perthshire Open Studios (POS) to exhibit in the POS Summer Exhibition. You can still register as a member of POS for 2023 but you should allow time between registering as a member and registering for the POS Summer Exhibition. 2. Online exhibition registration – four steps

- a) As part of the exhibition registration process, all members are requested to check the details they previously included under their POS member profile. Log in using your username (you can request to reset your password if required).

- b) Once membership details have been confirmed, please complete the separate online registration form for the POS Summer Exhibition. This Google Forms form collects the details for a single piece of art, up to 12 smaller items that will fit in a display case, i.e. jewellery or ceramics, etc., and either 12 individual cards or 6 packs of cards.

You should receive an email acknowledgement of your registration (if not please get in touch).

Please note: this year there will be no print racks/viewers available.

- c) Once the registration form is completed, please send an image of the artwork by email to angela@perthshireopenstudios.com. This step is required to complete your submission.
- d) After the registration closes on 31st May 2023, your application will be confirmed within the week. Please note that due to limited space and allowing for replacement of sold items, we will create a reserve list but we reserve the right to reject pieces, typically for being inappropriate for the audience or in terms of quality of presentation.

3. Closing Date

The exhibition registration form detailing works to be submitted must be completed by **5pm on Wednesday 31st May 2023. You will be emailed to confirm acceptance.**

4. Restrictions apply

Only one piece of art per member, excepting smaller items like jewellery, where up to 12 pieces will be accepted to be displayed in a case. The single piece of original art may be:

- wall art, painting, mixed media, etc., up to a maximum size of 1m by 1m. All wall art must have medium or large D-rings with string or wire attached for hanging.
- sculpture in any media (glass, cement, ceramic, willow, etc.). Indication should be given if the piece requires a plinth or is floor standing. Dimensions will be required for floor / plinth based art.
- jewellery, ceramics, etc., that you are happy to have displayed on a shelf in a display case. Please be aware only to include enough to display on a single shelf.

In addition, an artist may include up to:

- 12 individual cards **OR** 6 packs of cards.

These details will all be collected on the registration form.

5. Labelling

All work being submitted must be labelled with the artist name, title of work, medium, display requirements and sales price (including Birnam Arts commission: 25% plus VAT, or 30%).

Cards can simply be labelled with the artists name (unless the back of the card has those details printed) and a sales price (including the Birnam Arts commission as above).

6. Drop Off

Where: Birnam Arts, Station Road, Birnam, PH8 ODS

When: **Tuesday 27th June, 9.30–11.30am and 6–8pm.**

If you cannot manage these times, an alternative time can be arranged.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Bank details will be collected at drop off. Please ensure that whoever is dropping off your work has this information.

Remember, for drop off:

- All work **MUST** be labelled with the same information that is registered.
- All excess boxes, wrapping and packaging materials must be taken away with you on the day of drop off. Any key protective packaging left behind may be reused: we cannot guarantee the same packaging will be returned to you.

7. Collection of Works

Where: Birnam Arts, Station road, Birnam, PH8 ODS.

When: **Monday 17th July 11:30am–1:30pm and 6–8pm.**

If you cannot manage these times, an alternative time can be arranged. However, Birnam Arts will be setting up for a new exhibition from the

18th July, so we may have to relocate your work for collection depending on the number of pieces not collected.

Remember, for collection:

- Bring your own boxes, wrapping and packaging materials.

8. Preview Evening

An invitation to the preview evening on **Friday 30th June, 7–9pm** will be sent shortly after registration closes but please do pop the date into your diary when you register. There will be a prize competition for best artwork on the evening, selected by the attendees with the a prize of £250 to be awarded.
