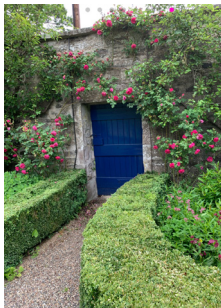
Diana of Diana King Jewellery is returning to the Bield this year as our experienced artist in residence and a veteran of Perthshire Open Studios, having enjoyed her previous stints, chatting to visitors, exhibiting her wonderful Sterling silver and resin pieces. Diana always manages to design something new for each exhibition, we're looking forward to seeing what it is this year.

Our 2nd artist in residence, Jo Perkins, is new to the Bield and to Perthshire Open Studios. Jo is a painter and art educator based in rural Perthshire, whose practice centres on colour, its relationships, its expressive power, and its capacity to unlock something in the people who study it. Her paintings are characterised by luminous, layered colour and energetic mark-making, working primarily in acrylics across landscape and floral subjects.



Our 3rd artist in residence is Kerri Watson of K Laverock Textile Art, again new to both the Bield and Perthshire Open Studios. Kerri creates unique wet and needle felted art using locally sourced, sustainable and ethically produced wool. She handcrafts a range of sculptures, pictures, wall hangings and jewellery inspired by wildlife, nature and the beautiful Scottish landscapes of home.

While each artist develops their own distinct practice, the shared environment encourages experimentation, exchange, and the growth of a personal voice.



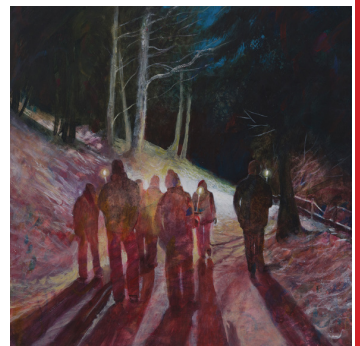
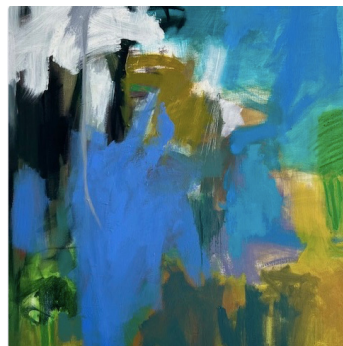
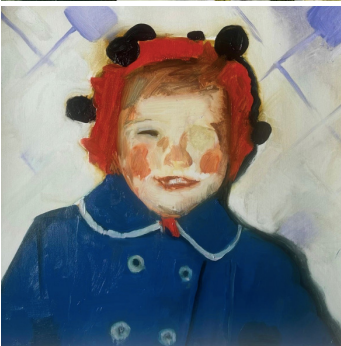

I'm a self-taught artist using layered, textured acrylics to capture the wildlife I know well. My years working with various animals, including big cats, at Edinburgh Zoo taught me to translate their texture, movement and essence onto canvas, capturing the beauty between power and vulnerability.

From Coupar Angus, head south on the A923 Dundee Rd, turn left to Ardler. We are the first farm on the left. Coming from the Forfar Rd A94 in Coupar Angus, turn right at lights past East of Scotland Country Store, then right at junction.
